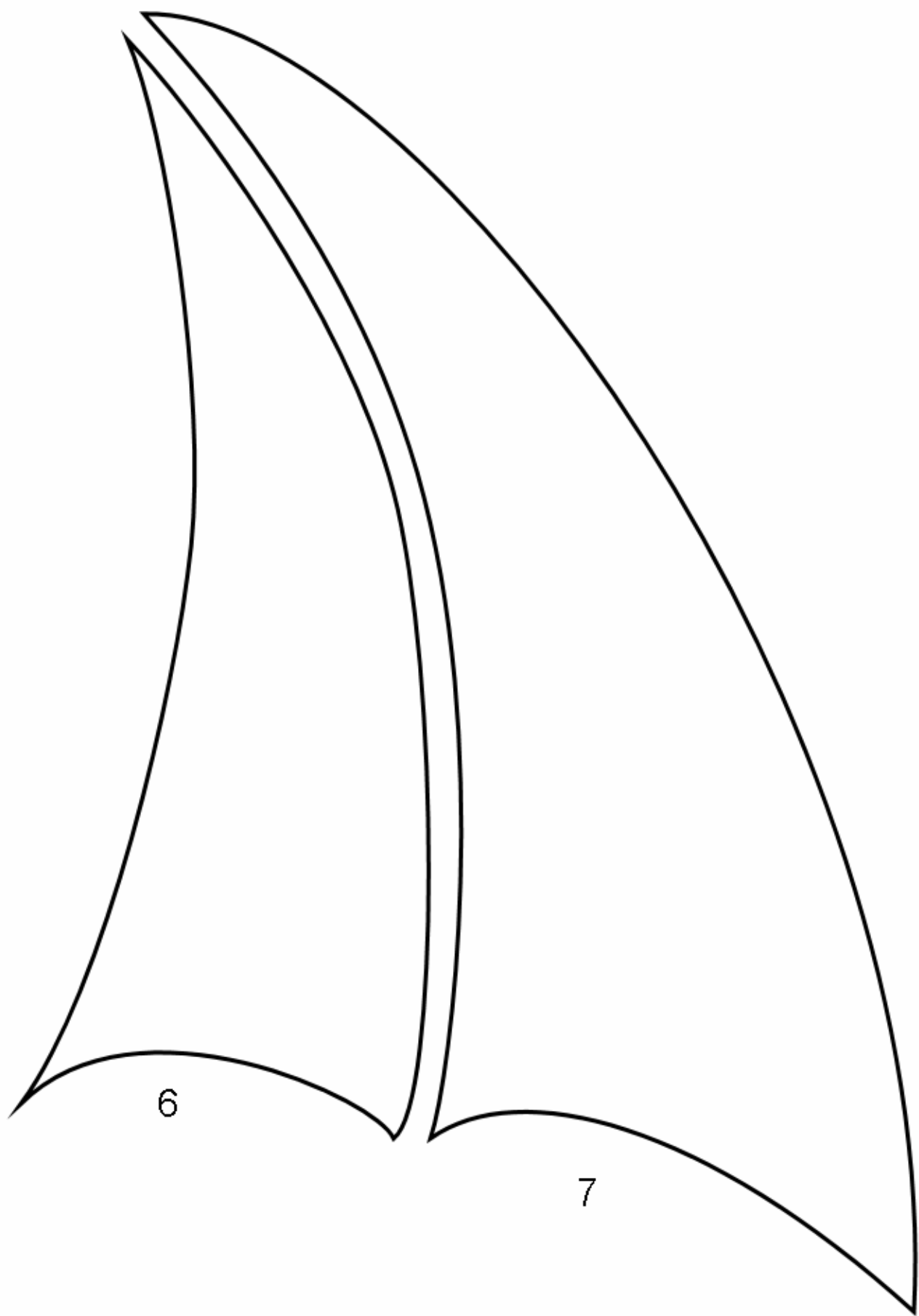
There are two versions of this in this file. Pages 2,3 and 4 are just the basic outline you can cut out and trace on to black cardstock, scrapbook paper or whatever you want. If you make it with black cardstock, you can use double stick tape to put it in your window for Halloween. Pages 5, 6 and 7 are the colored version I used on my wall. I recommend using a repositionable glue stick or repositionable spray to adhere it so it can be removed after the holidays. As usual, test your walls in a section that doesn't show with a piece of paper with the repositionable glue to make sure it doesn't mark your walls.

After you cut out the pieces, assemble them from the center, marked as piece 4, out.





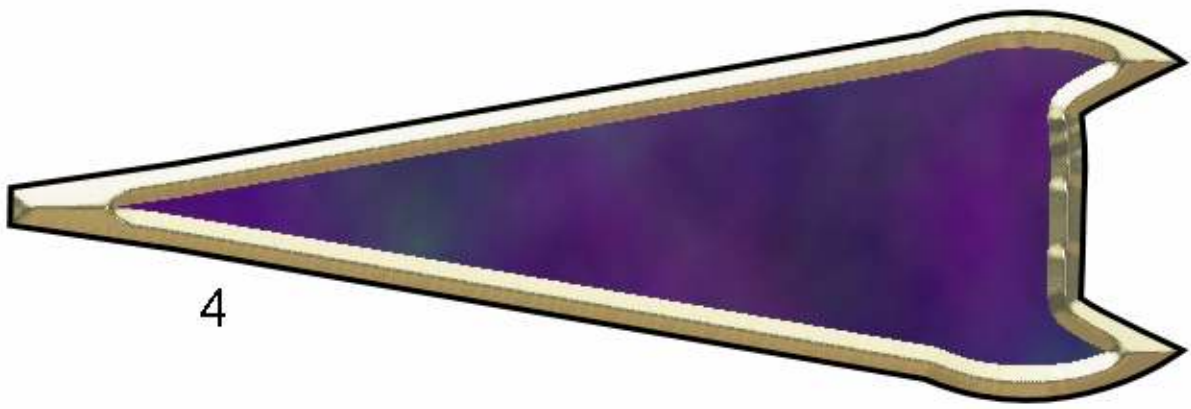
